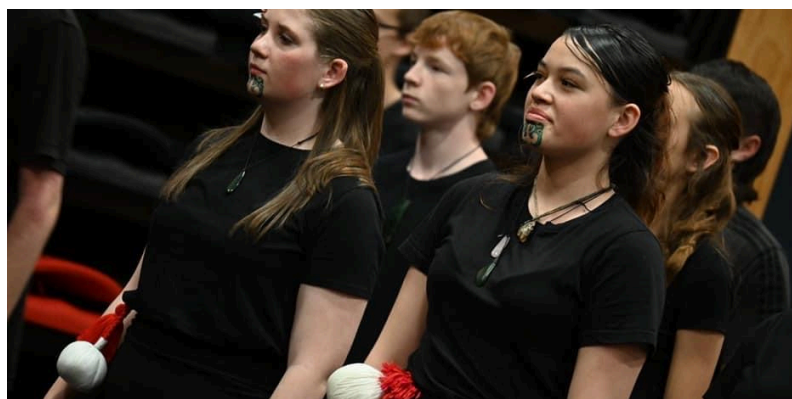

Pastoral Care



The welfare of our students at Lincoln High School is our utmost priority. We have 24/7 care available.

The International Directors will be available to assist students, families and agents. We meet each student at the airport, along with the host parents. All international students will live in either carefully chosen families arranged by the school; with their parents or legal guardian; or a designated caregiver.

Our team arrange and monitor homestay placements for our students. These are carefully selected and matched to meet the unique needs of each student.

Each student participates in our orientation programme to familiarize them with their new environment. Each student also has a Linc teacher, Tutor, Dean and Head of Year.

There is also an excellent student counselling team available. Our staff are extremely friendly and helpful throughout your academic and cultural journey at Lincoln High School.
