<b>How was the funding used?</b>	<p>This funding was used to support the flexible learning space we provide for our year 11-13 students and it allows us to provide teaching staff to support these students.</p> <p>The students in this space are at risk of not achieving an NCEA qualification or need support to continue with NCEA class work when on a dual enrolment programme. This space allows us to provide an individualised programme to students that can be tailored to their needs and interests. They can gain credits towards their NCEA qualification, and the skills learnt may support future study or employment beyond high school.</p>
<b>What were the outcomes resulting from funding?</b>	<p>Students get to work in a nurturing environment where they can receive small group or 1 to 1 support on various standards. This means they are able to be more successful at gaining credits towards their NCEA qualification. The US credits offered are at an accessible level for the students which gives them a positive learning experience and feeling of success on their learning journey.</p>
<b>Issues, concerns, highlights, and other comments</b>	<p>No issues or concerns. We are very thankful to have this funding to support our senior students. The support we can provide from this funding leads to positive outcomes in a safe space for students who are at risk of not achieving an NCEA qualification.</p>
